Tornado Safety

Be informed

- > Tornado season in Corinth occurs from late February to the end of May. However tornadoes may strike any time of the year.
- > Know the weather forecast for the week. Watch your favorite news channel or listen to your preferred radio station.
- > Tornadoes can strike anywhere, on mountains, near rivers, near lakes. Nowhere is safe
- The most dangerous part of a tornado are the flying debris. Objects in a tornado can move at speeds greater than 150mph
- Listen to NOAA Weather Warning Radio for updates and warnings of impending natural disasters. The national weather service broadcasts updated weather conditions and forecasts 24/7.

What to Do

- 1. Develop a plan beforehand for your family and you.
- 2. Have a pre-designated area of safety such as basement or a tornado shelter.
- 3. Have supplies ready such as a first aid kit, disaster supplies kit
- 4. Stay informed. Listen to KNTU88.1 for emergency services in Corinth.

NOAA Tornado Alerts

- Tornado Watch- there is a possibility of tornadoes. Remain alert.
- Tornado Warning a tornado has been sighted in your area. Please move to your pre-designated area of safety

Do Not

- Try to outrun a tornado in your car instead exit the vehicle and find a nearby ditch to lie in.
- Seek shelter in a mobile home. Mobile homes offer little protection.
- Leave windows open. Open windows allow dangerous winds and debris to enter the structure.

The city of Corinth will coordinate emergency services, public information, and recovery efforts to assist the community in the event of a tornado.
